Secrets of Revelation

Say (O' Prophet SAW)! I seek refuge with the Rabb of mankind, the Real Sovereign and the True Monarch of everyone; against the whisperer unto the hearts of people, whether he be of the Jinn, or mankind who, due to constant obedience to Satan, also acquire his traits.

Labid bin 'Aşim, a Jew stole some sacred hair of the Holy Prophet saw, tied these in knots around the teeth of a comb and buried the comb under a stone in an

abandoned well. The Holy Prophet was taken ill. Informed through revelation, he had the comb recovered from the well. It is then that these two Surahs (al Falaq and an Nās) were revealed and with each Ayah a knot was untied and the Holy Prophet recovered. So through hum, his entire Ummah has been blessed with a perfect formula for protection and cure against all forms of witchcraft and magical manipulations. Now whenever the Holy Prophet felt indisposed, he would recite these Sūrahs, blow on his hands and rub them over his entire body.
